Strengthening PNG's response through private sector collaboration

HUMANITARIAN CRISIS

With **41.6** million cases worldwide and over a million deaths, the rate of COVID-19 infection continues to grow. Alongside the human suffering, the pandemic threatens livelihoods, reverses development and intensifies poverty. Building nationwide resilience to COVID-19 is in the interest of every business in PNG and the customers, employees and communities they serve.

PNG IS AT HIGH RISK

While only 583 confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been recorded to date (October 20, 2020), the actual number of cases may be much higher due to limited national testing capacity. The case for continued vigilance and preparedness in PNG's private sector is compelling. The reliance of key industries on fly-in-flyout workers significantly increases the risk of imported cases, and the workplace as a potential vector leading to infection in close-knit communities cannot be underestimated. A high disease burden, limited infrastructure and poor access to healthcare leaves PNG vulnerable.
